## VOTER ELIGIBILITY & REGISTRATION OPTIONS

- \* Must be a United States citizen. MUST BE a resident of Washington State.
- \* Must be 18 years of age by November 3, 2020.
- \* Must update your voter registration (1) if you have moved since the last election, (2) changed your name, (3) to request an out-of -state or -country ballot.
- \* Download/print voter registration forms at [www.sos.wa.gov/elections/print-voter-registration-forms.aspx](http://www.sos.wa.gov/elections/print-voter-registration-forms.aspx).
- \* Request voter registration form(s) from your local County Auditor's Office.

**Primary Election** **AUGUST 4**      **General Election** **NOVEMBER 3**

## OTHER IMPORTANT DATES & DEADLINES

- \* Friday, October 16, 2020 – **Start of 18-day voting period** (through Nov 3)
- \* October 26, 2020 – **Online and mail registrations** must be received 8 days before Election Day.
- \* Tuesday, November 3, 2020 – **Last Day to Return Ballots By USPS**, (must be postmarked 11/3/2020)
- \* Tuesday, November 3, 2020 – **Last Day to deposit your ballot in an official drop box by 8 p.m. on Election Day.**
- \* Tuesday, November 3, 2020 – **Last Day to Register to Vote (in person only)** during business hours and any time before 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
